Hickory Museum of Art welcomes homeschool parents and students to experience an art-filled, educational year of activities where the birth of a creative thought becomes a tangible object. Students will be led through the galleries while examining works of art on their level.

Following gallery inspiration, students will then create artwork of their own. Different media will be used each month for experimentation. Each month will focus on a different art process/technique, utilizing the museum's various exhibitions while teaching a broad-based knowledge of art fundamentals. Competency goals in art, language arts, and social studies will be met throughout the year following the NC Common Core and Essential Standards.

Classes are designed for students ages K-8th grade. Students are divided into three age groups (depending on grades enrolled). Kindergartners must be five by October 1, 2023 to participate.
